# AUDIO BOOKS NOW AVAILABLE ON THE 3M CLOUD

In addition to *Southern Illinois Libraries On the Go*, the library now makes available to its patrons the **eRead Illinois 3M Cloud Library**. This source of eBooks is accessible directly through the library's catalog. You do need to download an app to use this eBook library on your device (Nook, Android, Kindle Fire or one of the many other devices this system works with), PC, or Mac. For information on downloading the needed app, go to ebook.3m.com. Currently, the collection contains over 7,300 titles, many of which are new releases and currently reside on best seller lists. This resource was made available through a grant from the Illinois State Library.
