

Cloud Library Installation Instructions for the Kindle Fire

Kindle Fire: **1st generation***

(2011— 2012)

If you receive a **"parsing the package"** error while attempting the Cloud Library app download, this set of instructions should fix the issue.

Kindle Fire: 2nd & 3rd generations

(2012— 2014)

If you download the app but you receive an **"incompatible"** error when trying to install, the following steps should help.

Kindle Fire

(2014—present)

These instructions have been updated to reflect the new OS released with the \$50 Kindle Fire 7 in December 2015.

Allow Apps from Unknown Sources Setting (this setting must be turned on no matter which Kindle Fire you have)

Using the web browser on your Kindle Fire, **visit the website: Slideme.org**. Type "3M Cloud Library" into the Application Search Box.

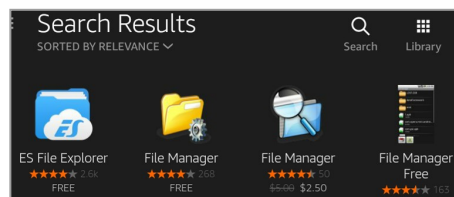
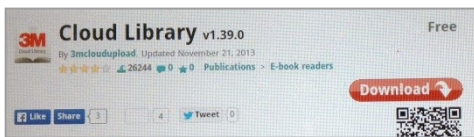
Visit yourcloudlibrary.com, using the web browser (Silk). Click on the Kindle Fire button (left side of page). Scroll down & tap on the blue "Download" button. Return to the Kindle Fire home screen.

Visit yourcloudlibrary.com, using the web browser (Silk). Click on the Kindle Fire button (left side of page). Scroll down and tap on the blue "Download" button.



The Cloud Library app should appear in your search results. Tap on "Download" to download the app.

Tap on "Shop" in the menu at the top of the screen. Select "Apps" on the left side. Search for "File Manager". Download the free app, "ES File Explorer".



Once the download is complete, view notifications (swipe down from the top of the screen). Tap on the first notification to install the Slideme File Manager App. Follow the prompts and the Cloud Library app will download automatically.

Open the app. Tap on the "X" in the upper right hand corner to close the homepage. You should see several file folders. Tap on the one that says "Downloads". Once open, tap on the Cloud Library icon to install the app.

Tap on the notification that says "Download Complete", then tap on the MMMCloudLibrary file to begin installation. Follow the prompts.

If the "download complete" notification disappears before you can tap on it, you can still access the file. Open up the web browser (Silk) and tap on the list icon in the upper left-hand corner. Tap on downloads and the MMMCloudLibrary file should be listed.
